SWAELTJIE NES INFORMATION

Swaeltjie Nes is the Afrikaans for Swallow's Nest. It is a rustic off-grid mountain hut that can only be reached on foot. It is built against a huge rock with the rock forming the back walls of the bedrooms – hence the name Swaeltjie Nes / Swallows Nest.

Cost per night: R170 per adult and R110 per child (4-17 years old)

Check-in: 10h00 to 17h00 (except if otherwise arranged)

Check-out: any time before 16h00

Bookings need to be made 2 days before the arrival date.

The email must contain the following information:

- Departure date
- No of adults
- No of children 4-17

General Information:

- Swaeltjie Nes (SNes) is located 300m from the parking at campsite 3
- **SNes can only be reached on foot** - luggage and food have to be carried there
- Guests who require assistance need to arrive in Meiringskloof before 15h00
- Vehicles may temporarily be parked at campsite 3 to unload luggage & goods, Once unloaded, vehicles must be parked in the parking area next to the office
- SNes currently has two rooms, one room has a double bed and 4 single beds, the other room has 6 single beds
- Each bed has a mattress with fitted sheet, pillow and pillowcase
- *Guests need to bring their own bedding/sleeping bag/duvet, and towels*
- **There is no electricity but solar lights, and a port to charge a cellphone**
- The undercover braai area / lapa in front of SNes has a table with seating for 12 people, kitchen sink, donkey for hot water, and built-in braai
- Adjacent to the undercover area is an open braai area and seating
- The donkey can supply hot water to the basin and shower, if fire is made underneath
- Firewood can be bought if needed, and staff will deliver it there
- Toilet paper is supplied for the neat pit-toilet / "long-drop" toilet
- One outside shower is linked to the donkey for hot water; as an alternative the showers in the camping area's ablution block can be used

Equipment supplied:

- 3 rechargeable Magneto LED lights, which can be exchanged at the office the next day if needed (Useful when showering and at the braai area)
 - 4 kg gasbottle with top, kettle for boiling water, pan, pot, egg lifter
 - Bread board, braai tongs, long fork, 2 large serving spoons
 - Vegetable peeler, kitchen knife, bread knife, tin opener, wine bottle opener
 - Dishwash soap, dishcloths and drying cloths, sponge, and pot scourer
 - 12 sets of crockery and cutlery, which includes a knife, fork, spoon, teaspoon, big plate, bowl, mug, wine glass, and drinking glass
